**Title:** *Medical Directorships and Mid-Level Supervision Care*

Objectives:

1. Participants will understand the circumstances under which a medical director of a hospice agency may be subject to Medicare enrollment revocation and preclusion.
2. Participants will understand how to structure compliant compensation for a medical director, including in circumstances where the medical director also refers patients to the agency.
3. Participants will understand the key requirements and components of agreements that must be in place for a physician to supervise a mid-level practitioner; specifically: Collaborative Practice Agreements and Delegation of Prescriptive Authority Agreements.
4. Participants will have a general understanding of the safeguards that must be in place for compliant physician ownership of a home health or hospice agency.
5. Participants will receive instruction on the importance of safeguarding the assignment of their billing privileges, and steps participants can take to monitor the use of their billing privileges.
